We are pleased to present the annual report of the academic year 2024-25 containing important events, milestones and achievements.

Student strength of BGMS Shishukunj Vidyalaya rose to 337 with many students joining from other schools in the neighborhood. Quality English medium education free of cost has been a beacon of hope for the economically weaker sections of the area.

We have achieved yet another year of excellent results in SSLC exams with a pass percentage of 95%. It has been possible through our dedicated team of teachers and additional coaching provided by volunteers.

Our revamped playground, indoor sports facilities, Maths and science labs along with the newly inaugurated Library provides children with holistic learning experience. Children too have brought laurels to the school in various inter school, taluk and district level sports and cultural competitions.

Awareness programs have been conducted on topics like health, environment nutrition providing useful information and perspectives to children.

New bio glass plant, Solar plant and ground water recharging points have augmented our efforts towards a green campus and sustainability.



The child care institution continues to function with its full sanctioned capacity and the old age home of 55 inmates capacity has an average occupancy rate of 80%.

Shakti Sadan has been a great source of support for not only women who come in for temporary shelter and counselling and also providing overnight shelter for rescued women brought in by the police stations in the vicinity

Various Institutional and Individual donors have contributed generously towards all our activities. We thank them immensely for their trust and support

BGMS management also appreciates and applauds the dedicated efforts of the teachers and staff members for providing a cheerful environment for all the inmates.

2024-25 has seen us march with renewed confidence in this journey of 63 years.

125 underprivileged children were provided shelter at BGMS Child Care Institution. Children were provided with hygienic environment, nutritious food, education, healthcare, counselling, awareness sessions, extracurricular activities and a caring atmosphere. Our donors, corporate companies and volunteers were actively involved with BGMS staff and management to make the hostel a lovely home for the children. Our biggest accomplishment is the smile on each child's face.

License under the Juvenile justice act was renewed for the third time. BGMS JJ Act License is valid up to Nov 2029. 100% children were produced before the child welfare committee and admissions are done as per the guidelines of the CWC/DCPO office and the Women & child department, Govt. of Karnataka. Details of all the children are uploaded to the 'Mission Vatsalya' portal with their CWC ID number. As mandated by the Government all children have been provided with Aadhar card, bank account and Ayushman Card. Staff members and wardens make sure that all compliances are fulfilled in time. Children are provided with nutritious meal. Corporate companies and large hearted Individuals donated generously towards food, Milk, eggs and fruits enhancing the nutrition given to the children.

All Children of BGMS CCI are studying at BGMS Shishukunj Vidyalaya except a few who have studied in Kannada medium till middle school, they are sent to a nearby Kannada Medium school.

Children who are in need of special attention are provided with assistance with the help of teachers and volunteers.

Regular awareness programmes on health, environment and social causes, extracurricular activities like sports, drawing, painting are organised for holistic development of the children. Children are also taught basic tasks like cleaning, cooking and many DIY (Do it Yourself) work towards making them independent and responsible. Regular health check up is done by visiting doctors and through free health camps organised by charitable hospitals.

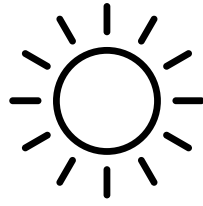
